We have been so lucky to gain the services of Mr Garth Ratcliffe who lost 4 members of his own family at this tragedy. On December 21, 1910, a total of 344 men and boys lost their lives, after an explosion underground in the Hulton Bank Colliery No. 3 Pit, the 3rd worst mining disaster in British history.
