Personal History

Harry ALEXANDER was born at Leeds, Yorkshire in 1890.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Back Lloyd Street, Kirkstall Road, Leeds,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Lees as an Extra Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Scots Guards at Leeds, Yorkshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 7 October 1914. His last known address was Leeds, Roundhay Road, Roseville Road, Kelper Grove, 16 (Aunt) Mary Ann Spencer

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 29 October 1914 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
