Personal History

Younger Sykes PARKINSON was born at Halifax, Yorkshire in 1885 the son of John Christopher and Elizabeth PARKINSON nee HAIGH who were married 27/04/1889 at St. John the Baptist, Halifax, Yorkshire. His father died on .

In the 1901 census the family were living at 20, Johnson Street, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16

In the 1891 census the family were living at 28, P. He was aged Hill with the occupation of Ovenden, Yorkshire, Age 6.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie PARKINSON (nee MOSEY) They married at St. John, Coley, Yorkshire on 19 October 1912

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Halifax as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 12 August 1914. His last known address was Halifax, Pellon Lans, Horne Street, 36 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 March 1915 aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
