Personal History

Ernest PARRY was born at Newton Heath, Manchester, Lancs. in 1898 the son of Benjamin and Mary Ann PARRY nee ROYAL who were married 1888 at West Bromwich, Staffordshire. His father died in 1906. His mother died in 1906.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 147, Lightbourne Road, Moston, Manchester, Lancashire.. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 10, Delta Street, Moston, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath as a Coachmaker

He was living at Moston, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Middleton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 August 1917 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
