Personal History

Thomas Aspinall PEACOCK was born at Darwen, Lancashire on 16 February 1890 the son of Charles Aspinall and Mary Ann PEACOCK nee STUTTARD who were married 1875 at Blackburn - Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1940. His mother died in 1940.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 200, Blackburn Road, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Bitchers Assistant.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 79, Giilbrand Street, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at 59 & 61, Blackburn Road, Over Darwen, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 1

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Darwen as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Darwen, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 9 May 1915. His last known address was Darwen, Lancashire (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 21 November 1917 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
