Personal History

Richard Arthur PEARSON was born at Wakefield, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of Richard and Lucy PEARSON nee HOLMES who were married 10/10/1881 at All Saints, Wakefield, Yorkshire. His father died in 1933. His mother died in 1933.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Clarendon Street, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Errand Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 29, York Street, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

He enlisted in the York and Lancaster Regiment at Wakefield, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 October 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
