Personal History

Thomas William PETTINGER was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1890 the son of Tom and Hannah PETTINGER nee FARMERY who were married 1889 at Goole, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 23, Pasture Road, Goole. Yorkshire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Hairdresser.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 6, Heathmill Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 11

In the 1891 census the family were living at 35, Jackson Street. Horwich, Yorkshire,. He was aged 1

He was a married man. His wife's name was Jane Lydia Mary PETTINGER (nee WALKER) They married at St. John, Balby, Doncaster, Yorkshire on 20 January 1913. They had children: Tom b. 1914, Nora b. 1915

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He was living at Goole, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Mercantile Marine.

He is recorded as Died on 7 April 1918 aged 28
