Personal History

John Clement PHILLIPSON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1893 the son of William and Sarah Mary PHILLIPSON nee GARRETT who were married 1888 at Goole, Yorkshire. His father died in 1939. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 17, Bournville Pasture Road, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Railway Engine Cleaner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 53, Manuel Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 8

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mabel PHILLIPSON (nee WOOD) They married at St. Philip & St. James Clifton Church, York on 29 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Goole as a Claener

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 July 1916 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
