Personal History

George William PICKERING was born at Hurdsfield, Macclesfield, Cheshire in 1895 the son of George and Eliza PICKERING nee MORGAN who were married 1888 at St. Peter, Prestbury, Cheshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Smyth Street, Hurdsfield, Macclesfield, Cheshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railwat Cart Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 77. Arbourhey Street, Hurdsfield, Macclesfield, Cheshire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Cheshire Regiment at Macclesfield, Cheshire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Hurdsfield, Macclesfield, Smyth Street, 8 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died on 31 July 1917 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
