Personal History

Arthur William PLANT was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Arthur and Annie Elizabeth PLANT nee NOTON who were married 1894 at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire. His father died in 1952. His mother died in 1952.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 7, Grundy Hill, Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of House Painter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 7, Grundy Hil, Horwich, Bolton, Lancshie,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Welsh Fusiliers at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 September 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Bolton, Grundy Hill, 7 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 18 September 1918 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
