Personal History

George Wallace PLATTS was born at Barnsley, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Mathias and Frances PLATTS. In the 1911 census the family were living at 72, Smith Street, Chapeltown, Sheffield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Iron Moulder.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Royal Rifle Corps at Sheffield, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 21 July 1915. His last known address was Garforth, Leeds, Garforth House Cottage (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 2 April 1918 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
