## Personal History

Robert William PORTER was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Thomas and Mary Jane PORTER nee DEAN who were married 26/03/1894 at St. Mary-le-Gill, Barnoldswick, Preston.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 1, Lathom Street, Chesham, Bury, Lancashire.. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Clerk

## Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 25 September 1914. His last known address was Chesham, Bury, Lathom Street. 1 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 August 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
