***Personal History***

*Albert Edward POWELL was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1894 the son of John and Anne POWELL nee ASHMORE who were married 1890 at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Winter Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Labourer, Sanitary Ware Works.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Julia Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 6*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 31 July 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Lancashire, Winter Street, 6 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 November 1916 aged 22*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
