*Frederick PRICE was born at Cound, Staffordshire in 1899 the son of Thomas Parsons and Elizabeth PRICE nee MADELEY who were married 1881 at Codsall, Staffordshire. His father died on .*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer*

*He was living at Cressage, Shropshire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire at Shrewsbury, Staffordshire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 May 1918 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
