Personal History

Herbert P. (Greenwood) PRIESTLEY was born at Newtown, Huddersfield on 2 November 1898 the son of Sarah Hannah PRIESTLEY nee Preistley.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Brentom, Sowerby, Luddenfoot, Yorkshire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Part Time School/Doffer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 31. Old Lee Bank, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

He enlisted in the Durham Light Infantry at Halifax, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 July 1918 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
