They had children: Stanley b.1911 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Oldham Road as a Porter

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 18 July 1915. His last known address was Broughton, Salford, Fred Street, 13 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 6 July 1916 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
