Personal History

Thomas PUGH was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1891 the son of Thomas and Sarah PUGH. In the 1911 census the family were living at 7, Church Place, Everton, Liverpool, Lancahire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Goods Dept.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 71, China Street, Everton, Liverpoo;, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 11, Abbey Street, Everton, Lancashire.. He was aged 8 weeks He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen Elizabeth PUGH (maiden name not known) Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Lines Dept. at Liverpool as a Collector

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Royal Rifles at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 13 August 1914. His last known address was Everton, Liverpool, Church Place, 7 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 September 1914 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
