Personal History

Edwin Frank RABBICH was born at Paignton, Devon in 1888 the son of Frank Goodridge and Sarah Louisa RABBICH nee WEBBER who were married 1887 at Totnes, Devon. His father died in 1896. His mother died in 1896.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 10a, South Street, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Servant, Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Buckingham Street, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 In the 1891 census the family were living at Winner Street, Paignton, Devon,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. as a Shunter

Service History

He was living at Rochdale, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Rifle Brigade at the same place. and embarked for France on 30 July 1915. His last known address was Roichdale, Lancashire, South Street, 10a (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 13 July 1916 in 36th Casualty Clearing Station aged 28 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
