Personal History

Thomas RANCE was born at Preston, Lancashire in 1883 the son of Thomas and Ann RANCE nee ROBINSON who were married 11/07/1880 at St. Marks, Preston. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at HMS 'Apollo' Davenport, Plymouth,. He was aged 27 with the occupation of Stoker 1st Class.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Fulwood Barracks, Preston.. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Soldier Infantry.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 13, Pollard Street,. He was aged 8 with the occupation of Scholar. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Holder-Up

He enlisted in the Royal Naval Reserve.

He is recorded as Died on 6 June 1915 aged 32
