***Personal History***

*Charles James RANOE was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1897 the son of John Charles and Elizabeth Ellen RANOE nee LINDSAY who were married 1893 at Newcastle upon Tyne. His father died in 1936. His mother died in 1936.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 14, Mount Pleasant Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of App. Railway Eng. Fitter.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal Norh Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancasahire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Horwich, Mount Pleasant Street, 14 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 30 October 1917 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
