*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Fazakerley as a Point Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 21 February 1915.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 May 1918 aged 30*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
