Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Fazakerley as a Point Cleaner

Service History

He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 21 February 1915.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 May 1918 aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
