Personal History

Albert Edward REGAN was born at Newtown, Wigan, Lancashire in 1894 the son of William and Elizabeth Annie REGAN nee APPLETON who were married 1893 at Wigan Register Office or Registrar Attended. He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Wigan, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 6 May 1915. His last known address was Higher Tranmere, Birkenhead, Gleenway Road, 53 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 May 1915 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
