***Personal History***

*Albert Edward REGAN was born at Newtown, Wigan, Lancashire in 1894 the son of William and Elizabeth Annie REGAN nee APPLETON who were married 1893 at Wigan Register Office or Registrar Attended.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 153, Ormskirk Road, Newtown, Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Pit Brow Boy.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 153, Ormskirk Road, Newtown, Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 7*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Wigan as a Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Wigan, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 6 May 1915. His last known address was Higher Tranmere, Birkenhead, Gleenway Road, 53 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 May 1915 aged 21*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
