*George RITCH was born at Glasgow, Lanarkshire, Scotland in 1897 the son of George and Nellie RITCH. In the 1911 census the family were living at 273 Burlington Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of A Scholar.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 2/7, Burlington Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Copyist*

***Service History***

*He was living at Liverpool. Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 November 1917 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
