Personal History

Charles Robinson BELL was born at Barton on Humber, Lincolnshire in 1889 the son of Wiliam Gladstone and Rosanna Elizabeth BELL nee ROBINSON who were married 1888 at Knareborough Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 70, St Helier Road, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Porter.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Charleswoth Cott. He was aged with the occupation of Harrogate, Yorkshire, Age 2.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at St. Annes as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Lancaster Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire. and embarked for Asiatic on 17 July 1915. His last known address was Blackpool, St. Heliers Road, 70 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 July 1916 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
