Personal History

George Matthias ROGERSON was born at Fleetwood, Lancashire in 1891 the son of Thomas and Henrietta ROGERSON nee WELLS who were married 1880 at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1902. His mother died in 1902.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 50, Kent Street, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 96, Promenade Road, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at 44, Walmsley Street, Thorton, Fleetwood,. He was aged 1 Month

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Puller-up

Service History

He was living at Fleetwood, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Fleetwood, Lancashire, Kent Street, 50 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 June 1915 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
