Ernest ROSKELL was born at Fleetwood, Lancashire in 1890 the son of John and Jane ROSKELL.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Hotel and Refreshment Rooms at Liverpool as a Steward

He enlisted in the King's Own Lancaster Regiment at Fleetwood, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 September 1915.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 17 July 1917 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
