Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Wakefield, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 13 April 1915.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 20 December 1915 in 10th Casualty Clearing Station He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
