Personal History

Michael ROURKE was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1890 the son of William and Francis Ann ROURKE nee BUTLER who were married 1887 at Salford Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1958. His mother died in 1958.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Brewery Place, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Railway Carter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 21, Brooks Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 In the 1891 census the family were living at 7, Richmond Terrace, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 Months He was a married man. His wife's name was Sarah A ROURKE (nee BRAMWELL) They married at Sacred Trinity, Salford, Lancashire on 28 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goode Managers Dept. at Salford as a Carter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 September 1915. His last known address was Salford, Brewery Place, 8 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 April 1917 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
