Personal History

Samuel ROWBOTTOM was born at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire in 1877 the son of William and Mary Ann ROWBOTTOM nee BOOTH who were married 18/09/1859 at Glossop, Derbyshire.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth Hannah ROWBOTTOM (nee BOSTOCK) They married at Ashton Under Lyne Register Office or Registrar Attd. on 18 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Ashton as an Extra Porter

Service History

He was living at Duikinfied, Cheshire when he enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 1 January 1915. His last known address was Stalybridge, Cheshire, High Street. 1A (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died on 27 April 1916 aged 39

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
