Personal History

Thomas ROWE was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Charles and Emma Mary ROWE nee HILL who were married 1886 at Madeley, Shropshire. His father died in 1956. His mother died in 1956. In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Round Street, Bowling Old Lane, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Round Street, Bowling Old Lane, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Bradford

Service History

He was living at Bradford, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Aldershot. and embarked for France on 24 August 1915. His last known address was Bradford, Yorkshire, Bowling Old Lane, Round Street, 6 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 November 1917 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
