Personal History

John William RULER was born at Manchester, Lancashire (Ireland) in 1891 the son of John James and Mary J. RULER nee MURRAY who were married 1879 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended. In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Sunderland Street, Harpurhey, Manchester,. He was aged 20 Railway Carriage Cleaner

In the 1901 census the family were living at Poor Law Scholl, Chorley Road, Swinton, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 97, Albert Street, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Victoria

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 September 1918 aged 27 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
