***Personal History***

*Reginald Whitwoth SABINE was born at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire in 1898 the son of Arthur Thomas and Amy SABINE nee WHITWORTH who were married 14/09/1897 at Hurst Brook Methodist New Chapel (Hope Chapel). His father died on .*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Essex Street, Levenshulme, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 15, Romney Street, Hurst, Ashton Under Lyne,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk*

***Service History***

*He was living at Old Trafford, Manchester when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 11 October 1917 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
