## Personal History

Reginald Whitwoth SABINE was born at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire in 1898 the son of Arthur Thomas and Amy SABINE nee WHITWORTH who were married 14/09/1897 at Hurst Brook Methodidt New Chapel (Hope Chapel). His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Essex Street, Levenshulme, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged d 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 15, Romney Street, Hurst, Ashton Under Lyne,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He was living at Old Trafford, Manchester when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 11 October 1917 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
