***Personal History***

*Thomas SALE was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1881 the son of William and Sarah SALE nee HAYWARD who were married 1870 at Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1892.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 55, Curtis Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Railway General Labourer.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 46. Catherine Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 He was a married man. His wife's name was Catherine SALE (nee JACKSON) They married at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire on 17 March 1905*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept at Horwich as a Driller*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 11 June 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Lancashire, Motcliff, 3 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 June 1915 aged 33*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
