Personal History

Thomas SANDERSON was born at Preston, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Thomas and Rachel Mary SANDERSON nee SANDERSON who were married 1880 at Preston Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1948.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 64, Black Lane, Lostock Hall, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Black Lane, Lostock Hall, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Preston as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Scots Guards at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 January 1915. His last known address was Preston, Lancashire, Lostock Hall, Black Lane, 64 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 20 December 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
