Personal History

Norman Barnewall SAVAGE was born at Crosby, Liverpool in 1895 the son of George William and Mary Elizabeth SAVAGE nee EVANS who were married 31/12/1889 at St. John the Baptist, Toxteth Park, Liverpool. His father died in 1935. His mother died in 1935.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Great Howard as a Clerk

He was living at Waterloo, Liverpool when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 1 November 1914. His last known address was Great Crosby, Liverpool, Brookfield Avenue. 18 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 June 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
