*Died of Wounds 15 August 1915 aged 24*

***Personal History***

*Elijah SCOTT was born at Sudden, Rochdale, Lancashire in 1891 the son of William and Mary Ellen SCOTT nee POWNALL who were married 22/03/1889 at St. Alban, Rochdale, Lancashire. His mother died in 1923.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 212, George Street, Buckstone Road, Shaw, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 Cotton Piecer*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 22, South Street, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 9*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Todmorden as a Shunter*

***Service History***

*He was living at Accrington, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Rochdale, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Church, Accrington, Hagg Lane, Park View, 93 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 15 August 1915 in H.S. Formosa aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
