Personal History

Sylvester BENNETT was born at Armley, Leeds, Yorkshire on 27 January 1888 the son of Charles Herbert and Martha BENNETT nee RAMSDALE who were married 18/03/1882 at St. Peter, Leeds, Yorks=hire. His father died in 1930. His mother died in 1930.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 9, Cleopatra Street, Bramley, Leeds,. He was aged 3
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers
Dept. at Leeds as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Royal Rifles at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 13 August 1914.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 9 May 1915 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
