*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Dresser*

*He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Preston, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Died on 21 October 1918 in 29th Casualty Clearing Stn. France aged 24*
