Personal History

John William SEPHTON was born at Rainford, Lancashire in 1891 the son of John and Sarah Ellen SEPHTON nee DUTTON who were married 10/12/1878 at Christ Church, Kensington, Edge Hill, Liverpool. His father died in 1935. His mother died in 1935.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 10, Railway View, Rainford, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Porter.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Rainford as a Point Cleaner

He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Ormskirk, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 12 March 1915. His last known address was Rainford, Lancashire, Railway View, 10 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 September 1915 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
