*Killed in action 25 September 1915 aged 23*

***Personal History***

*John William SEPHTON was born at Rainford, Lancashire in 1891 the son of John and Sarah Ellen SEPHTON nee DUTTON who were married 10/12/1878 at Christ Church, Kensington, Edge Hill, Liverpool. His father died in 1935. His mother died in 1935.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 10, Railway View, Rainford, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Porter.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Railway View, Rainford, Lancashire,. He was aged 9*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Rainford as a Point Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Ormskirk, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 12 March 1915. His last known address was Rainford, Lancashire, Railway View, 10 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 September 1915 aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
