## Personal History

William BENSON was born at Bury, Lancashire on 24 September 1890 the son of William and Elizabeth BENSON nee MIDDLETON who were married 23/04/1881 at St. Paul, Chorlton-on-Medlock. His father died in 1909. His mother died in 1909.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6. Olivant Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 86, Horne Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 77, Horne Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Heywood as a Clerk

## Service History

He enlisted in the Grenadier Guards at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 16 March 1915. His last known address was Bury, Olivant Street, 6 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 July 1916 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
