Personal History

John SHACKLETON was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1891 the son of Harry and Mary Jane SHACKLETON nee DUNN who were married 1886 at Bradford, Yorkshire. His father died in 1945. His mother died in 1945.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 31, Addison Street, Hall Lane, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Goods Weiugh Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 48, Chandos Street, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 9 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Bradford, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Died on 21 December 1917 aged 27 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
