Personal History

Clifford Shortus SHARP was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1897 the son of Thomas and Mary A SHARP nee COLLIER who were married 1882 at Holy Trinity, Rothwell, Leeds, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 45, Adeline Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Grocers Errand Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 32, Vermingden Terrace, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Goole as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Strenstall, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 19 August 1915. His last known address was Goole, Yorkshire, Parliament Street, 68 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 August 1916 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
