Joseph Leo SHARPLES was born at Chorley, Lancashire in 1890 the son of Thomas and Teresa Alice SHARPLES nee ROWE who were married 1885 at Chorley Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1896. His mother died in 1896.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 68, Moister Road, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Goods Porter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14. Crabourne Street, Chorley, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 8, Bamber Street, Chorley. Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackpool as a Porter

He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 May 1917 aged 27
