Personal History

Walter SHORE was born at Wellington, Shropshire in 1894 the son of William George and Annie SHORE nee PUGH. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 19, Coerton Road, Aintree, Walton, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Cleaner Railway.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 33, Claremont House, Pendleton, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Aintree as a Fireman

Service History

He enlisted in the Rifle Brigade at Seaforth, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 22 July 1915. His last known address was Aintree, Liverpool, Coerton Road, 19 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 September 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
