Personal History

John Arthur SIMISTER was born at Swinton, Lancashire on 18 June 1894 the son of William Henry and Mary (Sarah) Alice SIMISTER nee SMITH who were married 1878 at St. Mary, Bury, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Swinton Hall Road, Swinton, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, Cobden Street, Swinton, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 July 1917 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
