Personal History

Percy SKAIFE was born at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire on 29 September 1891 the son of William Francis and Charlotte SKAIFE nee BRYQAN who were married 24/05/1890 at St. Michael, Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire. His mother died in 1934.
